Bamboo Flooring Maintenance Tips

What to do:

- Regularly clean the floor with a dust mop, soft bristled broom, soft bristled vacuum cleaner, or a wood floor mop kit.
- Immediately clean food and liquid spills with a slightly dampened cloth, then dry the floor with a soft cloth or towel.
- Use area rugs with non-abrasive or felt backing on high-traffic areas.
- Put felt or rubber pads under each furniture leg.
- Use sheer drapes, curtains, blinds, or window tint to limit direct sunlight on the floor. Sunlight will cause the Natural color to darken slightly. The Carbonized color will lighten due to the UV rays. Stained colors will also be affected by the sunlight
- Maintain humidity levels between 40% and 60% year-round

What not to do:

- Do not let sand, dirt or grit build up. This may cause scratches in the finish.
- Do not damp mop. Water may cause the floor to swell and cup.
- Place a drip pan under potted plants, but allow airflow underneath it.
- Do not walk on the floor with spike high heels or athletic cleats.
- Do not drag or push furniture across the floor.
- If you have pets at home, please keep any pets' claws closely trimmed.
- Do not use wax, oil soap, common household cleaners, or any abrasive cleaners
- Do not use throw rugs with rubber or vinyl backing without checking to determine if they will affect the floor's finish. Some materials in the backing can react with certain floor finishes, discoloring or causing the finish to become dull.

Refinishing/Recoating:

Proper care and maintenance can extend the life of the floor for many years; however, at some time a recoating may be desirable. Restore shine, if required, with an electric buffer and soft, dry pad. It is highly recommended to seek professional assistance when considering recoating or refinishing. Follow NWFA guidelines and standards. Deviation from NWFA guidelines voids all warranties.
